

PGA Championship picks 2016

PGA Championship picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Johnson finished 7th at the PGA last year and he finished 8th in 2013.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. McIlroy also has 3 top 10 finishes at the PGA over the past 4 years, including 2 wins.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.

Jason Day – Day has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Day is the defending champion at the PGA and he finished 8th at this event in 2013.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Kuchar finished 7th at the PGA last year.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Johnson finished 8th at this tourney in 2013.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Stenson finished 3rd at the PGA in 2013 and 2014.

Adam Scott – Scott has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Scott also has 4 top 15 finishes at the PGA over the past 5 years.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Reed finished 30th at the PGA last year.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 runner ups.
