

Sony Open Picks 2016

Sony picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Adam Scott – Scott has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Scott finished 8th at the Sony in 2014.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a trend with 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Kuchar has 4 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Johnson finished 8th at his event in 2014.

Charles Howell III – Howell is on a trend and he has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Howell has 3 top 10s at Sony over the past 4 years.

Russell Henley – Henley is on a trend with 2 top 10s in his most recent 2 events played. Henley won the Sony in 2013.

Harris English – English is another player on a trend to go along with 3 consecutive top 10s at this tourney in the past years.

Chris Kirk – Kirk has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Kirk finished 5th at the Sony in 2013 and 2nd in 2014.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win.

Daniel Berger – Berger is on a trend coming into this tourney to go along with 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Berger finished 13th in his Sony debut last year.

Peter Malnati – Malnati is another player on a trend with a 6th place finish at Hyundai last week to go along with 2 other top 10s in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.
