

## WGC Bridgestone picks 2016

WGC Bridgestone picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

**Jason Day** – Day has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Day finished 12<sup>th</sup> at Bridgestone last year and he finished 4<sup>th</sup> in 2011.

**Dustin Johnson** – Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win at the U.S. Open.

**Brooks Koepka** – Koepka has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played (2 runner-up finishes). Koepka finished 13<sup>th</sup> at the U.S. Open and he finished 6<sup>th</sup> at Bridgestone last year.

**Zach Johnson** – Johnson is on a trend and he finished 8<sup>th</sup> in his most recent event played, the U.S. Open. Johnson has 2 top 10 finishes at Bridgestone over the past 5 years.

**Jordan Spieth** – Spieth is on a trend and he finished 10<sup>th</sup> at Bridgestone last year.

**Shane Lowry** – Lowry is the defending champion at this event and he has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent events played, including a 2<sup>nd</sup> at the U.S. Open.

**Matt Kuchar** – Kuchar has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Kuchar also has 3 top 20 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years.

**Adam Scott** – Scott is on a trend coming into this tourney and he won it in 2011.

**Jim Furyk** – Furyk has 3 top 10 finishes at Bridgestone over the past 4 years.

**Charl Schwartzel** – Schwartzel is on a trend coming into Bridgestone and he finished 4<sup>th</sup> here in 2014.
