

WGC HSBC picks 2016

HSBC picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Johnson won HSBC in 2013 and he finished 5th last year.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 2 wins in his most recent 3 events played. McIlroy finished 11th at HSBC last year and he was 4th in 2011 and 6th in 2013.

Bernd Wiesberger – Wiesberger has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Wiesberger finished 17th at this event last year.

Bubba Watson – Watson is on a trend coming into this tourney to go along with 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Watson won here in 2014.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win and a second place finish last week.

Adam Scott – Scott has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Scott also has 3 top 15 finishes over the past times he's played at this event.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win last week at CIMB. Thomas finished 27th at HSBC last year.

Alexander Noren – Noren has 2 win in his most recent 5 events played.

Paul Casey – Casey has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Casey finished 4th at HSBC in 2011.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Reed finished 7th at HSBC last year.
