

WGC – Match Play Picks 2016

Match Play picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jason Day – Day won last week at Bay Hill. Day won the Match Play in 2014, he finished 3rd in 2013 and 9th in 2011.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Fowler has 3 top 10s at this event in the past 5 years.

Bubba Watson – Watson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he's 3 top 10s at this tourney in the past 5 years.

Adam Scott – Scott has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 wins.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 4 top 10 finishes at this event in the past 5 years, including a win in 2013.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Spieth finished 5th at the Match Play in 2014.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win, he's trending as well. Oosthuizen finished 5th at this event in 2015 and 2014.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. McIlroy is also the defending champion of the WGC Match Play.

Danny Willett – Willett has 2 top 3 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Willett finished 3rd at this event last year.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama is on a trend and he has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Matsuyama finished 9th at this tourney last year.
