

CIMB 2017 Picks

CIMB picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 2 wins and a 2nd in his most recent 5 events played. Thomas won this event last year and the year before.

Paul Casey – Casey has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Casey finished 21st at CIMB last year.

Xander Schauffele – Schauffele has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win at the Tour Championship. This is his first CIMB start.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama is on a trend coming into this event and he finished 2nd at this tourney last year and he was 5th in 2015.

Scott Piercy – Piercy is another player on a trend coming into this tourney and he finished in the top 10 at CIMB his last 3 starts here. (2016, 2015, 2012)

Kevin Na – Na is also on a trend coming into CIMB with 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played as well. Na finished 3rd at this event in 2015, 2nd in 2014 and 10th in 2012.

James Hahn – Hahn is another player on a trend coming into this event to go along with 2 top 10 finishes at CIMB in each of the last 2 years.

Gary Woodland – Woodland has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Woodland is on a trend coming into the event and he finished 2nd at CIMB in both 2014 and 2013.

Chez Reavie– Reavie has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Anirban Lahiri – Lahiri is on a trend coming into this event with a 9th finish in his most recent event played. Lahiri finished 3rd at CIMB last year.
