Hero Challenge 2017 Picks

Hero Challenge picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Justin Rose – Rose has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Rose finished 6th at Hero in 2014.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 2 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. This is his first Hero tourney.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Spieth won this event in 2014, he finished 6th last year and 4th in 2015.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 2 second place finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Fowler has 4 top 10 finishes at Hero over the past 5 years (didn't play in 2013).

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win in his most recent event. Koepka finished 7th at this tourney in 2015.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Stenson finished 2^{nd} at this event last year and 2^{nd} in 2014.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win and a second. Johnson finished 3rd at Hero last year.

Patrick Reed – Reed is on a trend coming into this event with a 10th finish in his most recent event played. Reed has 3 top 10s at this tourney over the past 3 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Matsuyama is the defending champion.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a slight trend coming into this event to go with 3 top 10 finishes at Hero over the past 4 years.
