

Tour Championship 2017 Picks

Tour Championship picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including 2 seconds. Spieth won this event in 2015.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Johnson has 4 top 10 finishes at The Tour Championship over his last 4 starts here.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 wins. Thomas finished 6th at this tourney last year.

Justin Rose – Rose has 3 top 10s in his most recent 3 events played. Rose has 4 top 6 finishes at this event over his last 4 starts here.

Paul Casey – Casey has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Casey finished 4th at this tourney last year and he finished 5th in 2015.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 3 top 10s. Fowler finished 12 at this tourney in 2015 and he finished 8th in 2014.

Jason Day – Day has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Day withdrew from this event last year but he finished 10th in 2015 and 4th in 2014.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. This is Rahm's first Tour Championship.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. This is Cantlay's first Tour Championship.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Simpson finished 4th at this event in 2013 and he finished 5th here in 2012.
