Career Builder picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Bill Haas – Haas has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Haas won this event in 2015 and he finished 9th last year and 6th in 2014.

Charles Howell III – Howell has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Howell finished 11th at Career Builder last year and he finished 2nd in 2013.

Webb Simpson – Simpson is on a trend coming into this tourney and he has 3 top 25 finishes at this event over the past 3 years.
