**Adam Scott** – Scott has 5 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is the defending champion.

**Justin Thomas** – Thomas finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at Honda last year to go along with 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins.

**Sergio Garcia** – Garcia has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Garcia finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at Honda last year and he finished 8<sup>th</sup> in 2014.

**Tyrrell Hatton** – Hatton has 5 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, 3 top 10s.

**Gary Woodland** – Woodland has 3 top 10 finishes and a 20<sup>th</sup> place finish in his most recent 5 events played.
