

John Deere picks 2017

John Deere picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has 1 top 30 finish in his most recent 2 events played. Johnson has 4 top 3 finishes at John Deere over the past 5 years, including a win.

Ryan Moore – Moore has 5 top 25 finishes at John Deere over the past 5 years and he is the defending champion.

Kelly Kraft – Kraft is on a trend coming into this event with a 5th finish last week at Greenbrier. Kraft finished 5th at John Deere last year.

Kevin Na – Na is on a trend coming into this event and he has 2 top 15 finishes at John Deere in his previous 2 starts here (2016 & 2014).

Daniel Berger – Berger has 2 top 2 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win.

Steve Stricker – Stricker is another player on a trend coming into John Deere. Stricker has 3 top 15 finishes over the past 5 years, and he won this event 3 years in a row (2009, 2010, 2011).

Brian Harman – Harman has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Harman won this event in 2014.

Kevin Streelman – Streelman has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Streelman finished 8th at this tourney in 2012.

Charley Hoffman – Hoffman has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played.

Jamie Lovemark – Lovemark has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a 3rd last week at Greenbrier.
