

Puerto Rico picks 2017

Puerto Rico picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Alex Cejka – Cejka is on a trend coming into this event with a 14th finish in his most recent event played. Cejka finished 11th at this event last year and he won it in 2015.

Graham DeLaet – DeLaet has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. DeLaet finished 11th at this tourney last year and he was 9th in 2012.

Wesley Bryan – Bryan has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Peter Uihlein – Uihlein has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Uihlein finished 6th at Puerto Rico in 2013.

Danny Lee – Lee is on a trend coming into this event to go along with a second place finish at this tourney in 2014.

Fabrizio Zanotti – Zanotti has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 2 events played, including a win. Zanotti finishes 27th at Puerto Rico in 2015.

Luke List – List is on a trend coming into Puerto Rico with a 17th finish as his most recent. List finished 15th in Puerto Rico last year.

Scott Brown – Brown has missed 2 cuts in a row coming into this event; however, Brown also has 4 top 10s in the past 5 years at Puerto Rico, including a win.

Boo Weekley – Weekley is on a trend coming into this event and he's 3 top 10 finishes at Puerto Rico over the past 5 years.
