

Shell picks 2017

Shell picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Stenson finished 2nd last year at Shell and he finished 2nd at Shell in 2013 as well.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Spieth was 13th last year and 2nd in 2015 at this tourney.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Mickelson finished in the top 20 in each of the past 5 years at this event.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Fowler finished 10th at Shell last year and he was 6th in 2014.

Justin Rose – Rose is on a trend coming into this event to go along with 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Charles Howell III – Howell is on a trend coming into this event and he's posted top 10 finishes at Shell in 3 of the past 4 years.

Russell Henley – Henley has 3 straight top 10 finishes at Shell over the past 3 years.

Charley Hoffman – Hoffman posted top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Holmes won Shell in 2015 and he finished 12th in 2014 and 8th in 2012.
