St. Jude picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

**Brooks Koepka** – Koepka has not missed a cut in his most recent 5 events played, which include 2 top 5 finishes. Koepka finished 2<sup>nd</sup> last year and 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2015 at St. Jude.

**Rickie Fowler** – Fowler has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Fowler finished 13<sup>th</sup> at this event in 2014.

**Phil Mickelson** — Mickelson is on a trend coming into this tourney and he hasn't missed a cut in his most recent 5 events played. Mickelson has 3 top 3 finishes at St. Jude in the last 4 years.

**Kevin Tway** – Tway has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

**Kyle Stanley** – Stanley has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

**Adam Scott** – Scott has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

**Francesco Molinari** – Molinari is on a trend coming into St. Jude and he's 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played (2 top 10s in his most recent 2). Molinari finished 34<sup>th</sup> last year.

Harris English - English is on a trend coming into St. Jude and he won the event in 2013.

**Peter Uihlein** — Uihlein has not missed a cut in his most recent 5 events played and he's on a trend coming into this tourney.

**Harold Varner III** — Varner is on a trend coming into St. Jude and, he finished 16<sup>th</sup> at this event last year.
