

The Open picks 2017

The Open picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia is on a trend and he has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Garcia finished in the top 6 in the last 3 Opens.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Fowler finished 2nd at The Open in 2014.

Zach Johnson – Johnson is on a trend coming into this event and he's posted top 12 finishes in 4 of the last 5 years at The Open, including a win in 2015.

Adam Scott – Scott is also on a trend coming into this tourney and he's 4 top 10 finishes at The Open in the last 5 years.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 4 top 26 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Stenson is the defending champion.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Reed finished 12th at The Open last year and he was 20th in 2015.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Spieth finished 4th at The Open in 2015.

Tommy Fleetwood – Fleetwood has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.

Paul Casey – Casey has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he's on a trend coming into this event.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.
