U.S. Open picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

**Dustin Johnson** – Johnson has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win (which was last in a string of 3 in a row). Johnson is the defending champion.

**Jason Day** – Day has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Day finished in the top 10 at the U.S. Open the past 4 years straight.

**Jason Dufner** — Dufner has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Dufner has 3 top 10 finishes at the U.S. Open over the past 5 years.

**Sergio Garcia** – Garcia has 5 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win (The Masters). Garcia finished 5<sup>th</sup> at Oakmont last year.

**Adam Scott** – Scott has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Scott has 4 top 20 finishes at the U.S. Open over the past 5 years.

**Jordan Spieth** — Spieth has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Spieth won the U.S. Open in 2015.

**Kevin Kisner** – Kisner has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Kisner finished 12<sup>th</sup> at the U.S. Open in 2015.

**Rory McIlroy** – McIlroy has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

**Paul Casey** — Casey has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he's on a trend coming into this tourney.

**Henrik Stenson** — Stenson has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Stenson has 3 top 30 finishes at the U.S. Open over the past 4 years.
