

Valspar picks 2017

Valspar picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Stenson finished 11th at Valspar last year and he finished 4th in 2015.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Thomas finished 18th at this event last year and he finished 10th in 2015.

Ryan Moore – Moore is on a trend coming into this event to go along with top 5 finishes at this tourney over the past 2 years.

Gary Woodland – Woodland has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Woodland finished 8th at Valspar in 2014.

Luke Donald – Donald has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Donald won this event in 2012 and he has two 4th place finishes - 2013 & 2014.

Graham DeLaet – DeLaet is on a trend coming into Valspar to go along with 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. DeLaet finished 5th at this event in last year and 8th in 2014.

Bill Haas – Haas has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Haas finished 2nd at Valspar last year and he was 14th in 2014.

Charles Howell III – Howell has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Howell finished 5th at Valspar last year, 10th in 2015 and 14th in 2014.

Jason Dufner – Dufner has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Dufner also finished inside the top 25 at Valspar in each of the past 5 years.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a slight trend coming into this event and he hasn't missed a cut at Valspar over the past 5 years.
