

WGC Match Play picks 2017

Match Play picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 2 wins in his most recent 2 events played. Johnson finished 5th at Match Play last year.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10 finishes in his 3 events played this year. McIlroy finished 4th at Match Play last year and he won in 2015.

Jason Day – Day is on a trend coming into the event and he is the defending champion. Day also won this tourney in 2014. That's 2 wins here in the past 3 years.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth is on a slight trend coming into this tourney to go along with 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Spieth finished 9th at Match Play last year.

Tyrrell Hatton – Hatton has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen is on a trend coming into the Match Play and he finished 2nd last year at the event – 5th in 2015 and 5th in 2014.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Snedeker finished 9th at Match Play last year.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Kuchar finished 9th at this event last year, 9th in 2014, he won in 2013 and he finished 5th in 2012.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.

Francesco Molinari – Molinari has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, he is also on a trend coming into this tourney.
