Dustin Johnson – Johnson won his most recent 3 events played. IF the back is fully healed, then he should contend.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson is on a trend coming into Wells Fargo and he's 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Paul Casey – Casey has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and 2 top 10s in his most recent 2 events played. And, he's on a trend coming into the tourney.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (3 are top 5s).

Kevin Kisner – Kisner has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 runner ups. Kisner is on a trend coming into this event as well.

Adam Scott – Scott is on a trend coming into Wells Fargo to go along with 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Brian Gay – Gay has back to back 6th place finishes in his most recent 2 events played.

Wesley Bryan – Bryan has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Recent win was at Harbour Town, not too far from Wilmington, where event is this week.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes is on a trend coming into Wells Fargo.

Kevin Tway – Tway has 2 top 3 finishes in his most recent 2 events played.
