

Wyndham picks 2017

Wyndham picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Stenson is also on a slight trend coming into this tourney.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner is on a trend coming into this event and he finished 7th at the PGA last week. Kisner finished 10th at Wyndham last year and he finished 8th in 2014.

Bill Haas – Haas has 4 top 20 finishes (3 top 10s) at Wyndham over the past 5 years. Haas has 3 top 40 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Webb Simpson – Simpson is on a slight trend coming into this tourney, and he's 2 top 10 finishes at Wyndham over the past 3 years.

Ryan Moore – Moore is another player on a trend coming into this event. Moore finished 10th at Wyndham in 2015.

Chris Stroud – Stroud has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played, including a win.

Seamus Power – Power has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Martin Flores – Flores has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Flores finished 16th at Wyndham in 2013.

Chad Campbell – Campbell has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Campbell finished 4th at Wyndham in 2012.
