

BMW Championship 2018 Picks

BMW Championship picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Bryson DeChambeau – DeChambeau has 2 wins in his most recent 2 events played.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Koepka finished 12th at BMW last year.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Johnson won this event in 2016.

Justin Rose – Rose has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (3 top 10s). Rose finished 2nd at this tourney last year.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Tiger Woods – Woods is on a trend coming into this event to go with 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Bubba Watson – Watson is another player on a trend coming into this tourney with a 7th finish at Dell this week. Watson has 3 top 20 finishes at BMW over the past 4 years.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth is another player on a trend coming into this event to go with 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Spieth has 5 top 20 finishes at BMW over the past 5 years (3 top 10s).

Francesco Molinari – Molinari has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Molinari finished 12th at this tourney last year.

Tony Finau – Finau has 3 top 10s in his most recent 4 events played. Finau finished 7th at BMW last year.
