

Byron Nelson 2018 Picks

Byron Nelson picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Jimmy Walker – Walker is on a trend coming into this event with 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including 2 top 10s in his most recent 2 events played. Walker was 2nd at this event in 2015.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. In addition, Kuchar is another player on a trend coming into this event. Kuchar has 3 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 4 years.

Rory Sabbatini – Sabbatini has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

Adam Scott – Scott is on a trend coming into Byron Nelson with an 11th place finish in his most recent event played – The Players.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Spieth finished 18th at this tourney in 2016.

Billy Horschel – Horschel has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Horschel is the defending champion (although the tourney is at a new course this year).

Charles Howell III – Howell is on a trend coming into Byron Nelson to go with 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Howell has 2 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell is another player on a trend coming into this event to go along with 2 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Marc Leishman – Leishman is on a slight trend coming into this tourney and he's 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Leishman has 3 top 15 finishes over the past 5 years at this event.
