Jordan Spieth – Spieth is on a trend coming into Colonial along with 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Spieth has 4 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years, including a win (2016).

Jimmy Walker – Walker has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Walker finished 10th at Colonial in 2014.

Chesson Hadley – Hadley has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, Hadley is also on a trend coming into this event and he finished 24th in 2015.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Rahm finished 2nd at Colonial last year.

Justin Rose – Rose has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 top 5s.

Adam Scott – Scott is on a trend coming into this tourney with 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Scott won Colonial in 2014.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win at the Players, his most recent start. Simpson finished 5th at Colonial last year and 3rd in 2016.

Aaron Wise – Wise has 2 top 2 finishes in his most recent 2 events played, including a win last week at Byron Nelson.

Jason Dufner – Dufner is on a trend coming into this event with a 5th place finish in his most recent event played. Dufner finished 6th at Colonial in 2016 and he finished 2nd in 2014.
