

Dell Technologies 2018 Picks

Dell Technologies picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Thomas is also the defending champion.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Koepka finished 18th at this event last year.

Patrick Reed – Reed is on a trend coming into Dell to go with 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Reed finished in the top 6 over the past 3 years at this tourney.

Jason Day – Day has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Day has 4 top 15 finishes at this event over the past 5 years (25th last year).

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. McIlroy won this event in 2016 and he finished 5th in 2014.

Adam Scott – Scott has back to back top 5s in his most recent 2 events played. Scott finished 4th at this tourney in 2016.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 4th place finishes in 2 of his 5 most recent events played. Rahm finished 4th at Dell last year.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Cantlay finished 13th at this event last year.

Tiger Woods – Woods has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Matsuyama has 3 top 25 finishes at this tourney over the past 3 years.
