

Farmers 2018 Picks

Farmers picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 2 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including 2 wins. Rahm is also the defending champion at Farmers.

Justin Rose – Rose has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Rose finished 4th at this event last year.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Fowler finished 6th at this tourney in 2013.

Brian Harman – Harman has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Harman finished 9th at Farmers last year.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Matsuyama was 33rd last year at this tourney.

Tony Finau – Finau has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Finau has 3 top 25 finishes at Farmers over the past 3 years, with a 4th finish last year.

Jason Day – Day has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Day won this event in 2015, he finished 2nd in 2014 and he was 9th in 2013.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Charles Howell III – Howell is on a trend coming into Farmers with 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Howell also has 4 top 20 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Shane Lowry – Lowry has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Lowry finished 7nd at Farmers in 2015.
