

Honda 2018 Picks

Honda picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is the defending champion. Fowler has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Fowler also hasn't missed a cut at Honda in the last 5 years.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Thomas finished 3rd at this tourney in 2016.

Gary Woodland – Woodland has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Woodland finished 2nd at this event last year.

Daniel Berger – Berger has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Berger finished 2nd at this tourney in 2015.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. McIlroy finished 2nd at Honda in 2014.

Tommy Fleetwood – Fleetwood has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. This is Fleetwood's first start at Honda.

Tyrrell Hatton – Hatton is on a trend coming into this event to go with 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Hatton finished 4th at this event last year.

Brian Harman – Harman has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Harman finished 11th at this tourney in 2015.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Garcia has 3 top 15 finishes at Honda over the past 4 years.

Russell Knox – Knox is on a trend coming into Honda as well as 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Knox also finished 3rd at Honda in 2015 and he finished 2nd in 2014.
