

## Mayakoba 2018 Picks

Mayakoba picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

**Rickie Fowler** – Fowler has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Fowler finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at Mayakoba last year.

**Tony Finau** – Finau has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Finau finished 7<sup>th</sup> at this event in 2014.

**Gary Woodland** – Woodland has 5 top 12 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Woodland finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at this tourney in 2016.

**Abraham Ancer** – Ancer has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Ancer finished 9<sup>th</sup> at this event last year.

**Denny McCarthy** – McCarthy has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

**Siwoo Kim** – Kim is on a slight trend coming into this tourney to go along with 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Kim also finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at Mayakoba last year and 17<sup>th</sup> in 2015.

**Emiliano Grillo** – Grillo is on a trend coming into Mayakoba with a 14<sup>th</sup> finish in his most recent event played. Grillo finished 9<sup>th</sup> at this tourney last year and 10<sup>th</sup> in 2016.

**Charles Howell III** – Howell has 2 top 25 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Howell has 3 top 10 finishes at Mayakoba over the past 5 years.

**Scott Piercy** – Piercy has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Piercy finished 4<sup>th</sup> at this tourney in 2016 and 16<sup>th</sup> in 2014.

**Billy Horschel** – Horschel has 3 top 11 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.
