Memorial picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Reed finished 8th at Memorial in 2016.

Justin Rose – Rose has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win at Colonial this past week. Rose finished 2nd at this event in 2015 and he finished 8th in 2013.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Johnson finished 3rd at this tourney in 2016.

Emiliano Grillo – Grillo has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 3 top 10s. Grillo finished 11th at Memorial in 2016.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a trend coming into Memorial and he's 2 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Kuchar finished 4th at this event the past 2 years and he won in 2013.
