

Pebble Beach 2018 Picks

Pebble Beach picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Johnson has won this event twice and he has 3 top 5s in the past 4 years.

Jon Rahm – Rahm is on a trend coming into Pebble Beach to go along with 2 wins in his most recent 5 events played. Rahm finished 5th at this event last year.

Jason Day – Day has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Day also finished in the top 10 at Pebble 3 times in the past 5 years.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 3 top 20 in his most recent 5 events played. Spieth is the defending champion.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Paul Casey – Casey has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Gary Woodland – Woodland has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Woodland finished 5th at Pebble Beach last year.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker is on a trend coming into this event and he's won this tourney 2 times in the past 5 years.

Patrick Reed – Reed is on a trend coming into this tourney. Reed finished in the top 25 at Pebble Beach over the past 5 years.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 4 top 20s in his most recent 5 events played. Cantlay finished 48th at Pebble last year and he finished 9th in 2013.
