RSM 2018 Picks

RSM picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Simpson finished 7^{th} at this event in 2013.

Lucas Glover – Glover has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he is on a trend coming into this tourney. Glover finished 9th at RSM in 2015.

Russell Henley – Henley is on a trend coming into RSM to go with 3 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 4 years.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner has made 4 cuts in his most recent 5 events played. Kisner won this event in 2015 to go with 4th last year, 4th in 2014 and 20th in 2013.

C.T. Pan – Pan is on a trend coming into RSM with 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Pan finished 13th at RSM last year and 6th in 2016.

Cameron Champ – Champ is another player on a trend coming into this event with 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win and he finished 10th last week.

J.J. Spaun – Spaun has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Spaun finished 2nd at RSM last year.

Nicholas Lindheim – Lindheim has not missed a cut in his most recent 5 events played to go with 3 top 20 finishes. Lindheim finished 13th at this event last year.

Denny McCarthy – McCarthy has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Jim Furyk – Furyk has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played and he's on a trend coming into this tourney. Furyk finished 6th at RSM in 2016.
