

Sentry TOC 2018 Picks

Sentry picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Spieth also finished 3rd at this tourney last year, he won it in 2016 and he finished 2nd in 2014.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Koepka finished 3rd at this event in 2016.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 3 top 2 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Fowler finished 5th at Sentry in 2016 and he finished 6th in 2013.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Johnson has 4 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 5 years, including a win in 2013.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Matsuyama finished 2nd at this tourney last year and he finished 3rd in 2015.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win and a second. Thomas is also the defending champion.

Xander Schauffele – Schauffele has 3 top 3 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Schauffele is also on a trend coming into Sentry.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win in his most recent tourney.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Cameron Smith – Smith has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.
