St. Jude picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

**Dustin Johnson** – Johnson has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Johnson finished 5<sup>th</sup> at St. Jude in 2016 and he won the tourney in 2012.

**Phil Mickelson** – Mickelson is on a trend coming into St. Jude. Mickelson finished in the top 11 for the past 5 years at this event (3 top 3s).

**Henrik Stenson** – Stenson comes into St. Jude on a trend with 5 top 25 finished in his most recent 5 events played, including 3 top 10s.

**Brooks Koepka** – Koepka has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he's on a trend coming into this event. Koepka finished 2<sup>nd</sup> here in 2016 and he finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2015.

**Tony Finau** – Finau has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Finau is also on a trend coming into St. Jude.

**Billy Horschel** – Horschel has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Horschel has 4 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

**Matt Jones** – Jones is another player on a trend coming into this tourney and he's 2 top 25 finishes over the past 3 years at St. Jude.

**Byeong Hun An** – An has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. An is also on a trend coming into St. Jude with a  $2^{nd}$  place finish at Memorial last week.

**Daniel Berger** – Berger has not missed a cut in his most recent 5 events played. Berger won this event last year and the year before.
