

U.S. Open 2018 Picks

U.S. Open picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Johnson is on a trend coming into this event and Johnson has 3 top 5 finishes at the U.S. Open over the past 4 years, including a win in 2016 at Oakmont.

Justin Rose – Rose has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Rose won the U.S. Open in 2012 at Merion.

Jason Day – Day has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Day has 4 top 10 finishes at the U.S. Open over the past 5 years.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Koepka has 4 top 20 finishes at the U.S. Open over the past 4 years. Koepka is the defending U.S. Open Champion.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is on a trend coming into this tourney. Thomas finished 9th at the U.S. Open last year and he finished 32nd at Oakmont in 2016.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Stenson has 3 top 30 finishes at the U.S. Open over the past 5 years.

Paul Casey – Casey has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Casey finished 26th at the U.S. Open last year.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is on a trend coming into this event. Fowler has 3 top 10 finishes at the U.S. Open over the past 5 years.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he is on a trend coming into this event. Rahm finished 23rd at the U.S. Open in 2016 at Oakmont.
