

Valspar 2018 Picks

Valspar picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth is the top ranked golfer in the field and he's 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Spieth won Valspar in 2015.

Adam Hadwin – Hadwin is the defending champion and he's 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Jason Dufner – Dufner has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Dufner has 5 top 25 finishes at Valspar over the past 5 years.

John Huh – Huh is on a trend coming into this event with 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Huh finished 9th at Valspar last year and he finished 22nd at this tourney in 2016.

Kevin Na – Na is on a trend coming into this event and he's 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Na finished 10th at this tourney in 2015 and he finished 2nd here in 2014.

Tony Finau – Finau has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Finau finished 5th at Valspar last year.

Paul Casey – Casey has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Casey is also on a trend coming into this event.

Charles Howell III – Howell has 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Howell has 3 top 15 finishes at Valspar over the past 4 years.

Justin Rose – Rose has 2 top 25 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Rose finished 8th at this event in 2014.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.
