

WGC - HSBC 2018 Picks

HSBC picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Justin Rose – Rose has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he is the defending champion.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win in his most recent event. Koepka finished 2nd at HSBC last year.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. McIlroy also has 2 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 5 years (played the event 3 times).

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Johnson finished 2nd at this tourney last year, 5th in 2015 and he won in 2013.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Matsuyama won HSBC in 2016.

Tony Finau – Finau has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Finau finished 11th at his event last year.

Matthew Fitzpatrick – Fitzpatrick has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Fitzpatrick is on a trend coming into this tourney and he finished 9th last year and 7th in 2015.

Tommy Fleetwood – Fleetwood has 3 top 10s in his most recent 4 events played.

Lucas Bjerregaard – Bjerregaard has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Eddie Pepperell – Pepperell has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.
