Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. McIlroy has 3 top 10s at the BMW over the past 5 years.

Justin Rose – Rose has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rose finished 2nd at this event in each of the past 2 years.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 2 second place finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Simpson has back to back top 10 finishes at BMW over the past 2 years.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Cantlay finished 9th at this tourney in 2017.

Paul Casey – Casey has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Casey finished 2nd at the BMW in 2016.

Rafa Cabrera-Bello – Cabrera-Bello has 3 top 10 finishes and a 12th finish in his most recent 5 events played.

Billy Horschel – Horschel has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Horschel has 3 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 5 years, including a win in 2014.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Koepka has 2 top 20 finishes at this tourney over the past 2 years.

Collin Morikawa – Morikawa has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. This is his BMW debut.
