

Byron Nelson 2019 Picks

Byron Nelson picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Aaron Wise – Wise has 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 2 events played and he is the defending champion.

Keith Mitchell – Mitchell is on a trend coming into Byron Nelson with an 8th finish last week at Quail Hollow. Mitchell finished 3rd at this tourney last year.

Rory Sabbatini – Sabbatini has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Sabbatini finished 13th at Byron Nelson last year.

Kevin Na – Na has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played and he finished 6th at this event last year.

Sungjae Im – Im has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played including 2 top 10s. Im is also trending coming into this tourney with a 31st finish in his most recent outing.

Scott Piercy – Piercy is another player trending coming into Bryon Nelson to go with 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Piercy finished 32nd at this tourney last year.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 2 second place finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama is on a slight trend coming into this tourney with a 31st finish in his most recent event played. Matsuyama was 16th at Byron Nelson last year.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson is another player on a trend coming into this event to go with 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Adam Schenk – Schenk has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Schenk finished 59th at Byron Nelson last year.
