

CJ Cup 2019 Picks

CJ Cup picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka is the defending champion and he has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Justin Thomas – Thomas won this event 2 in 2017 and he has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Matsuyama finished 18th at CJ Cup last year.

Jazz Janewattananond – Jazz has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Billy Horschel – Horschel has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Tommy Fleetwood – Fleetwood has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, 2 top 10s.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win.

Cameron Smith – Smith is trending coming into CJ Cup with a 13th finish in his most recent event played. Smith finished 7th last year at this event and he finished 3rd in 2017.

Tyrrell Hatton – Hatton has 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Hatton finished 14th at this tourney last year.

Viktor Hovland – Hovland has 5 top 11 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.
