

Canadian 2019 Picks

Canadian picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is the defending champion and he's 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. He finished 8th at this event in 2017 and he finished 2nd in 2016.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win in his most recent start at the PGA.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (3 top10s). Kuchar also has 3 top 10 finishes at the Canadian over the past 5 years.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker has 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Snedeker finished 8th at this event last year and he finished 5th in 2016.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Jimmy Walker – Walker is on a trend coming into the Canadian with a 19th finish in his most recent event played. Walker finished 29th last year and 14th in 2016.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. McDowell finished 17th at this tourney last year and he finished 9th in 2014.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

MacKenzie Hughes – Hughes is on a trend coming into the Canadian with an 8th finish in his most recent event played. Hughes finished 8th last year at this event and 32nd in 2017.
