

Houston Open 2019 Picks

Houston Open picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Stenson has 2 top 10 finishes at Houston over the past 3 years.

Russell Henley – Henley is on a trend coming into this event to go with 5 straight top 10 finishes at Houston over the past 5 years, including a win in 2017.

Daniel Berger – Berger is on a trend coming into Houston with an 18th finish in his most recent event played. Berger has 4 top 25 finishes at this tourney over the past 4 years.

Brian Harman – Harman has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Cameron Champ – Champ has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Lanto Griffin – Griffin has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Denny McCarthy – McCarthy has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played with a 9th finish in his most recent event played. McCarthy finished 43rd last year at Houston.

Richy Werenski – Werenski has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

Matt Jones – Jones has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Jones won this event in 2014.

Mark Hubbard – Hubbard has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Hubbard finished 19th at this event in 2016.
