

Quail Hollow 2019 Picks

Quail Hollow picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. McIlroy has 4 top 20 finishes at Quail over the past 5 years as well, including a win and 2 top 10s.

Jason Kokrak – Kokrak has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Kokrak finished 23rd at this event in 2014.

Paul Casey – Casey has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Casey finished 5th at this tourney last year.

Jason Day – Day is trending coming into this event with a 5th finish in his most recent event played. Day is the defending champion.

Justin Rose – Rose has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Rose also has 2 top 5 finishes in his last 2 starts at Quail Hollow (2016 and 2014).

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson is on a trend coming into this tourney with an 18th finish in his most recent event played. Mickelson has a top 20 in each of the past 5 years at this event (4 top 15s at Quail).

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Simpson finished 2nd at this event in 2015, he was 21st last year.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 5 top 35 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Matsuyama has 2 top 20 finishes at Quail over the past 4 years.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is on a trend coming into this event with a 9th finish in his most recent event played. Fowler finished 4th in 2016, 21st last year and he won here in 2012.

Lucas Glover – Glover has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Glover finished 8th at Quail Hollow in 2016 and he won here in 2011.
