Justin Thomas – Thomas has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Thomas is the defending champion.

Gary Woodland – Woodland has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Woodland finished 2nd at Honda in 2017.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Fowler won the Honda in 2017.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Simpson finished 5th at this tourney last year.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka is on a trend coming into Honda to go along with 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia is another player on a trend coming into this event to go with 3 to 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Garcia finished 2nd at this event in 2016.

Adam Scott – Scott has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Scott won the Honda in 2016 (14th in 2017 and 13th in 2018).

Cameron Smith – Smith has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he in on a trend coming into this tourney.

Lucas Glover – Glover has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Glover finished 17th at Honda last year.

Billy Horschel – Horschel has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Horschel finished 4th at Honda in 2017 and he finished 8th at Honda in 2016.
