

BMW Championship 2020 Picks

BMW Championship picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win and a second. Johnson won this event in 2016.

Jason Day – Day has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Day won this event in 2015 and he finished 4th in 2017.

Daniel Berger – Berger has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 3 top 5s. Berger finished 10th at BMW in 2016 and he finished 2nd in 2015.

Alex Noren – Noren has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Noren finished 24th at this event in 2018.

Xander Schauffele – Schauffele has 5 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Schauffele has 3 top 20 finishes at BMW over the past 3 years.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Rahm finished 5th at this tourney last year and also 5th in 2017.

Tony Finau – Finau has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Finau has 2 top 10 finishes at BMW over the past 3 years.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 3 top 15 finishes over his most recent 4 events played, 2 top 10s. Simpson also has 2 top 10s at BMW over the past 3 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Matsuyama has 3 top 15 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years.

Collin Morikawa – Morikawa has 2 wins in his most recent 5 events played, including a major.
