**Rory McIlroy** – McIlroy has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

**Webb Simpson** – Simpson has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Simpson finished 5<sup>th</sup> at Colonial in 2017 and he was 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2016.

**Jon Rahm** – Rahm has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (4 top 10s). Rahm finished  $2^{nd}$  at this event in 2017 and he was  $5^{th}$  in 2018.

**Kevin Na** – Na is the defending champion. Na finished 10<sup>th</sup> at this tourney in 2015 and he finished 4<sup>th</sup> in 2018. Na has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

**Kevin Kisner** – Kisner won this event in 2017. He finished 10<sup>th</sup> in 2016 and he was 5<sup>th</sup> in 2015. Kisner has 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

**Jordan Spieth** – Spieth has 4 top 10 finishes over the past 5 years at Colonial, including a win and 2 seconds. Spieth has 1 top 10 in his most recent 3 events played.

**Dustin Johnson** – Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

**Max Homa** – Homa has 5 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, 3 top 10s. Homa finished 27<sup>th</sup> at Colonial last year.

Bryson DeChambeau – DeChambeau has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

**Matt Kuchar** – Kuchar has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win and a second. Kuchar finished 6<sup>th</sup> at this event in 2016, 12<sup>th</sup> in 2017.
