

Safeway Open 2020 Picks

Safeway Open picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Brendan Steele – Steele is on a slight trend coming into this event with a 33rd finish in his most recent start, he hasn't missed a cut in his 5 most recent events and he is a 2x Safeway champion (2016 & 2017).

Chez Reavie – Reavie is another player on a slight trend coming into Safeway to go with 5 consecutive cuts made at this event.

Joel Dahmen – Dahmen has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Dahmen finished 46th at Safeway in 2018.

Rob Oppenheim – Oppenheim is on a trend coming into this tourney with a 15th finish in his most recent event played.

Talor Gooch – Gooch has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Siwoo Kim – Kim has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

Scott Piercy – Piercy is on a trend coming into Safeway with a 29th finish in his most recent event played. Piercy finished 17th at this event in 2017 and he finished 3rd in 2016.

Mark Hubbard – Hubbard has 2 top 30 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Hubbard finished 13th at this tourney last year.

Peter Malnati – Malnati is on a trend coming into this event with a 20th finish in his most recent event played. Malnati has 3 top 35 finishes at Safeway over the past 4 years.

Roger Sloan – Sloan is on a trend coming into this tourney with a 31st finish in his most recent event played. Sloan finished 13th at this event last year.
