

Sony 2020 Picks

Sony picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins (one last week). Thomas won this event in 2017, which was preceded by a win at Sentry the week prior.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Reed finished 13th at Sony last year.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Simpson also has 4 top 15 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years (he did not play this tourney last year).

Corey Connors – Connors has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Connors is trending coming into this event and he finished 3rd at Sony last year.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played (3 top 10s).

Chez Reavie – Reavie has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Reavie has 3 top 20 finishes at Sony over the past 3 years (2 top 10s).

Brendon Todd – Todd has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 wins.

Cameron Smith – Smith is on a trend coming into this tourney with a 10th finish in his most recent event played. Smith has 3 top 30 finishes at Sony over the past 3 years.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Kisner finished 4th at Sony in 2017 and he finished 5th at Sony in 2016.

Sungjae Im – Im has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Im finished 16th at this event last year.
