WGC Mexico picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Johnson is the defending champion and he won this event in 2017 and in 2015.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 5 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. McIlroy also has 4 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Adam Scott – Scott has 2 wins in his most recent 2 events played. Scott won this event in 2016.

Bubba Watson – Watson has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Watson has 3 top 10s at this event over the past 5 years.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Oosthuizen has 4 top 30 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Thomas also has 3 top 10 finishes at WGC Mexico over the past 3 years.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rahm finished 20th at this tourney in 2018 and he finished 3rd in 2017.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Garcia has 2 top 10 finishes at WGC Mexico over the past 2 years.

Tommy Fleetwood – Fleetwood has a win and 2 top 2 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Fleetwood has 3 top 20 finishes in the last 3 years at this event.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win in his most recent event played. Simpson finished 39th at WGC Mexico last year, he finished 37th in 2018.
