

CJ Cup 2021 Picks

CJ Cup picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Sam Burns – Burns has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, 2 top 10s, including a win.

Sungjae Im – Im has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a 3rd finish and a win.

Jason Kokrak – Kokrak is the defending champion to go along with 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

Harold Varner III – Varner has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he's on a slight trend coming into this event.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Tyrrell Hatton – Hatton has 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Hatton finished 3rd at CJ Cup last year.

Marc Leishman – Leishman has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Leishman finished 52nd at this event last year.

Shane Lowry – Lowry has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Lowry is also on a trend coming into this event with a 4th finish in his most recent event played. Lowry finished 28th last year at this tourney.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Thomas finished 12th at CJ Cup last year.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.
