

Palmetto 2021 Picks

Palmetto picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is the number one ranked player in the world. He's one top 15 finish in his most recent 5 events played, but he is from the area and this is a new course for the PGA Tour.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka is the second highest ranked player in the field, he also has 2 second place finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Vincent Whaley – Whaley is on a trend coming into Palmetto to go with 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Patton Kizzire – Kizzire has 2 third place finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

Garrick Higgo – Higgo has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins.

Alex Noren – Noren is trending coming into Palmetto with a 13th finish in his most recent event played to go along with 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Keith Mitchell – Mitchell has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Ian Poulter – Poulter is trending coming into Palmetto with a 3rd finish in his most recent event played. Poulter has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, with no missed cuts.

Ben Martin – Martin has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.
