

## Riviera 2021 Picks

Riviera picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

**Dustin Johnson** – Johnson has 2 wins and a second finish in his most recent 4 events played. Johnson posted top 10s at Riviera in 4 of the past 5 years, including a win in 2017.

**Patrick Cantlay** – Cantlay has 3 top 3 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Cantlay finished 17<sup>th</sup> at this event last year, 15<sup>th</sup> in 2019 and 4<sup>th</sup> in 2018.

**Rory McIlroy** – McIlroy has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he is on a slight trend coming into this tourney. McIlroy finished top 5 in each of the last 2 years at this event.

**Jon Rahm** – Rahm has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rahm finished 17<sup>th</sup> last year and 9<sup>th</sup> in 2019 at Riviera.

**Xander Schauffele** – Schauffele has a 5<sup>th</sup> and back-to-back 2<sup>nd</sup> finishes coming into Riviera to go with 3 top 25 finishes at this tourney over the past 3 years.

**Tony Finau** – Finau has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, back-to-back 2<sup>nd</sup> 's in his most recent 2 events played. Finau finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at Riviera in 2018.

**Viktor Hovland** – Hovland has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. This is Hovland's Riviera debut.

**Bryson DeChambeau** – DeChambeau has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win and 2 other top 10s. DeChambeau finished 5<sup>th</sup> last year at this tourney.

**Collin Morikawa** – Morikawa has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Morikawa finished 26<sup>th</sup> at Riviera last year.

**Adam Scott** – Scott is on a trend coming into Riviera with a 10<sup>th</sup> finish in his most recent event played. Scott is the defending champion to go with a 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2016 and a 7<sup>th</sup> in 2019.
